Hopefully in the summer term we will have some nice weather! Please can you ensure that on sunny days your child comes with a named sun hat and sun cream applied BEFORE playschool. The children will also need suitable clothes for playing outside. So, no strappy tops or flip flops and croc's need to have the back strap on.

Due to the current pandemic DO NOT send your child to playschool if:

You need to give them Calpol or equivalent

They have a new continuous cough

They lose their sense of smell

They have a temperature

If they are sneezing/have a runny nose due to a cold (normally this is not an issue, but as children are sneezing and coughing over the toys and us, I cannot risk another child or staff member being unwell).

Thank you for your continued support in social distancing and wearing masks outside when dropping off and picking up your children.

Flannel

Please can all children have a named flannel or small hand towel in their bags. The children use these to dry their hands after washing them. It is our way of stopping paper towel wastage. The flannel can be washed and reused again. Thank you.

Hair

If you child has shoulder length hair or longer please can we ask that you put their hair up. This makes it easier for them to see while playing and helps stop the spread of headlice if we have another case.

Rising Fives

The children who attend our rising fives sessions on a Tuesday afternoon will continue doing PE but every other week. The other weeks we will be doing letter and number work and other activities. Please can you provide a change of clothes for them to get changed into. Such as joggers or leggings and a t.shirt. They will also only get 30 minutes for their lunch to help prepare them for school. Please make sure you do not pack too much lunch for them so that they can achieve finishing their lunch in the time. Thank you.

If you child is poorly and not coming to playschool please ring the playschool number **07827 372960** or sign them out as sick on Famly giving a reason why they are off. A reminder that if you child has sickness or diarrhoea, please keep them off playschool until they have been clear of symptoms for 48 hours.
